The college offers a two-year Undergraduate Training Programme (B.Ed.) with the intake capacity of 100 students per year. It also offers a twoyear Postgraduate Training Programme (M.Ed.) with the intake capacity of 50 students per year. The courses are duly recognized and approved by the NCTE vide ERC/NCTE/APE00324/B.Ed. letter no. Order)/2015/32386 dated 29/05/2015 and letter no. 44294 dated 03/03/2016.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Under the academic leadership of Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar Bihar University, Muzaffarpur, and SCERT, Patna, the college offers the teacher training course of 02 Years Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.) and 02 Years Masters in Education (M.Ed.) course in regular mode. The college duly encompasses the curricular structure designated by the Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar Bihar University, Muzaffarpur.

The Details of B.Ed. Course Structure

The college offers 02 Years Regular B.Ed. Course which amounts for altogether 52 credits (26 Credits Each Year). Each Credit is equivalent to 16 hours of Theory and 32 hours of Practicum.

First Year of the course has been designed to provide wider awareness regarding the conceptual foundation of 'Education' as a discipline. Nature of learner, characteristics of developmental stages, concerning social issues, school as a social unit and the historical perspective of educational programmes and policies. The Details of M.Ed. Course Structure

The course aims to develop in-depth understanding of Educational Philosophy, Psychology, Sociology and Educational Research. The curriculum of Two Years Regular Masters in Education (M.Ed.) Course has been divided into 04 Semesters. The overall course amounts for altogether 84 credits with each credit equivalent to 16 Hours for Theory and 32 Hours for Practicum.
